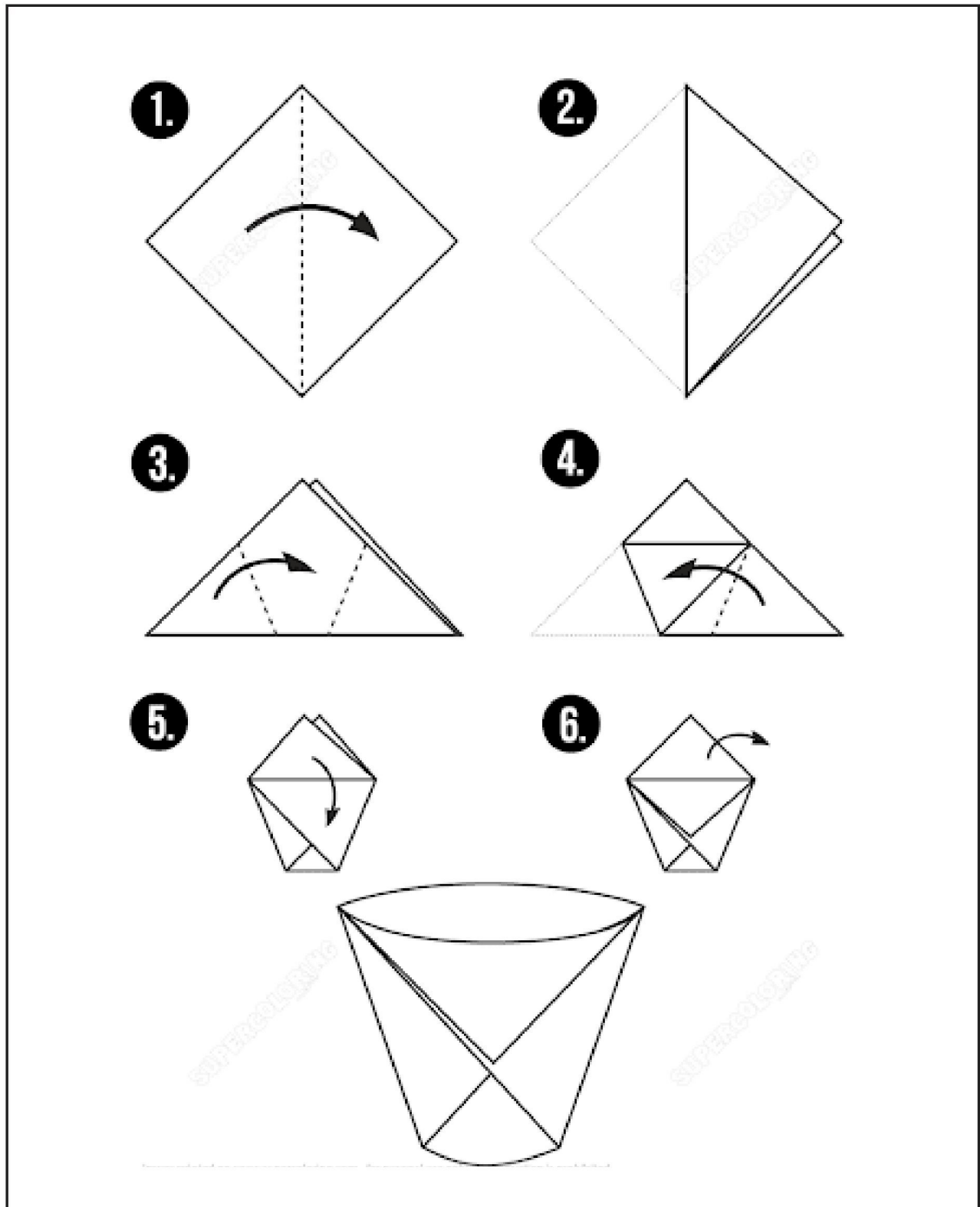

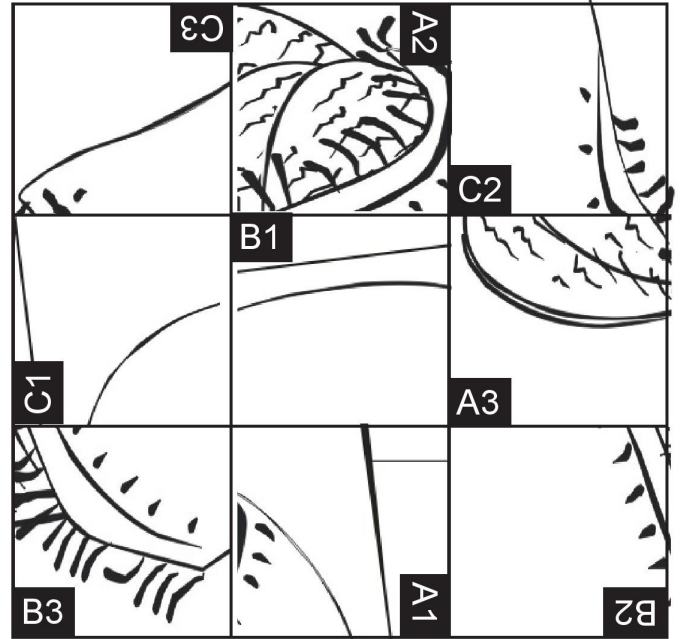

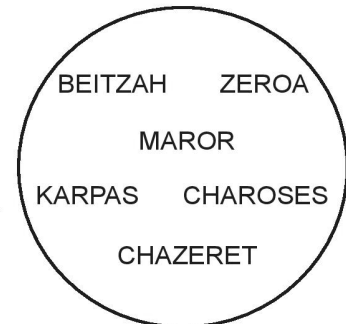
SEDER NIGHT ליל הסדר

You will need:

- A peice of hard cardboard, maybe from a box, approx 20x20cm
- 6 clear plastic cups
- glue and scissors
- textas or coloured pencils

1. Decorate your cardboard base
2. Colour in the circles below and cut them out
3. Cut your clear plastic cups so that they are only 2-3cm high
4. Glue the circles onto your cardboard in the correct order.
5. Glue the clear plastic cups on top.

Chazeret: Lettuce

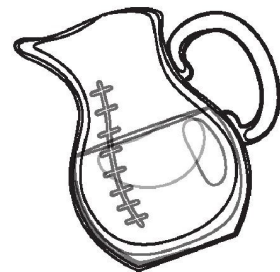
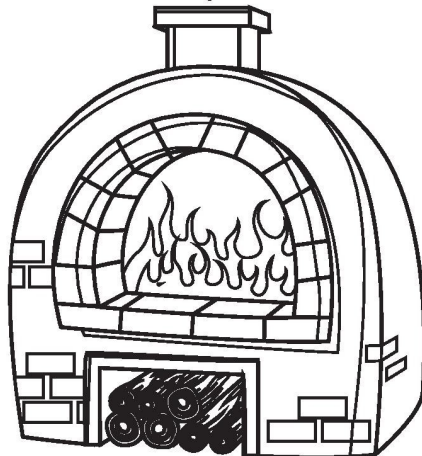
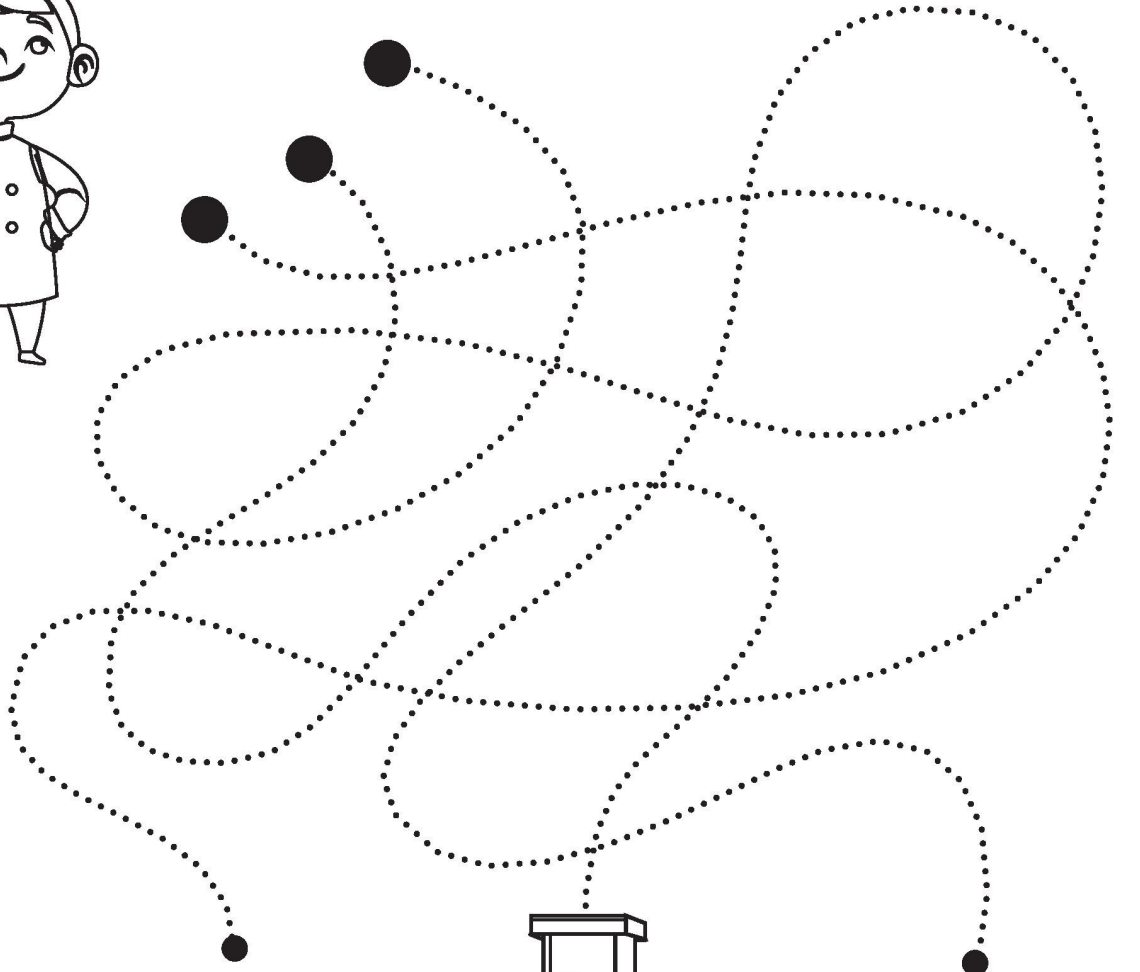
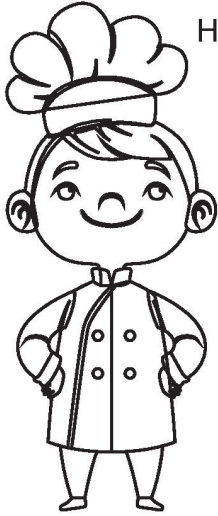
Be ready for Seder night.

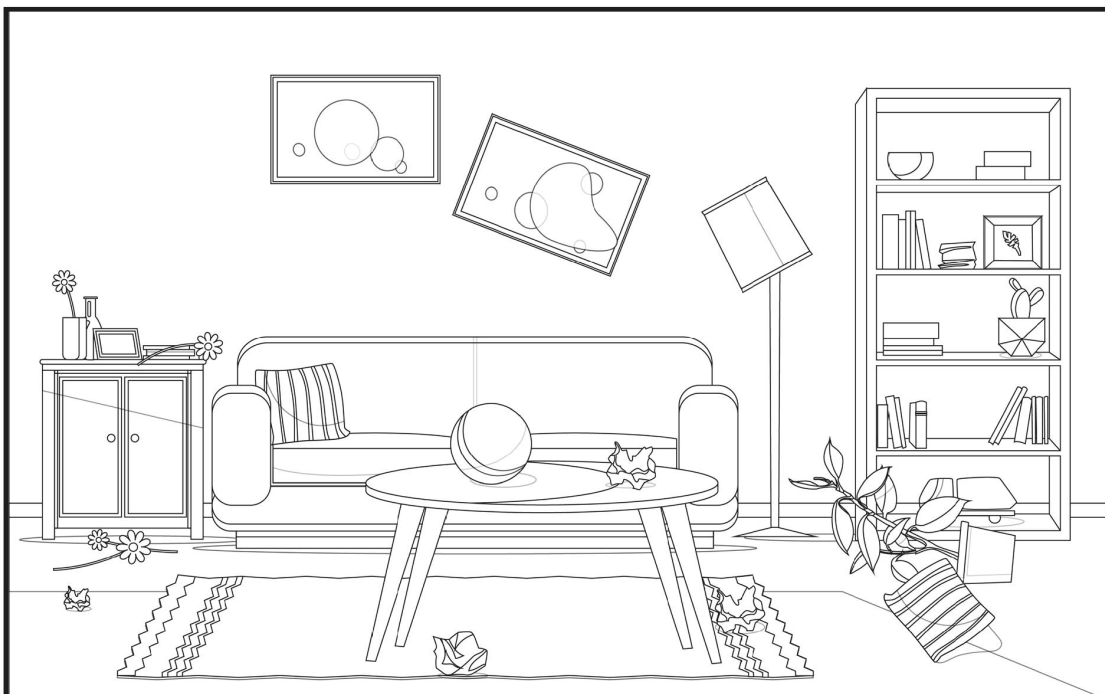
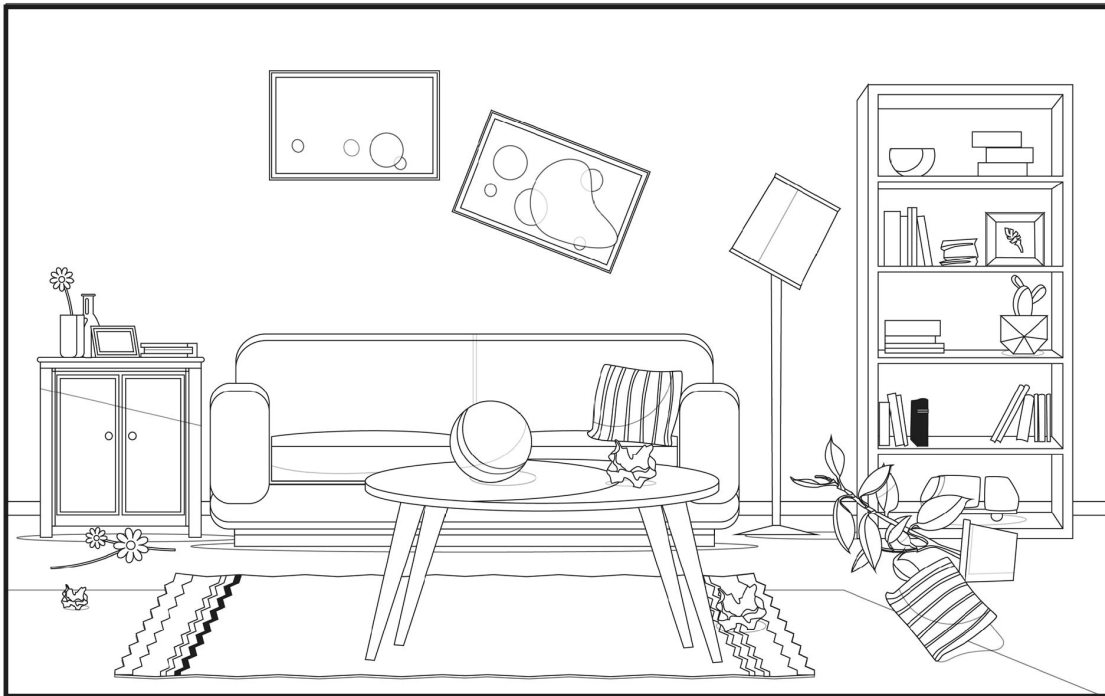
Help the flour and water get to the Matzah baker, and help the dough make its way back to the oven.





















We eat the Afikomen!

Can you spot 10 differences?

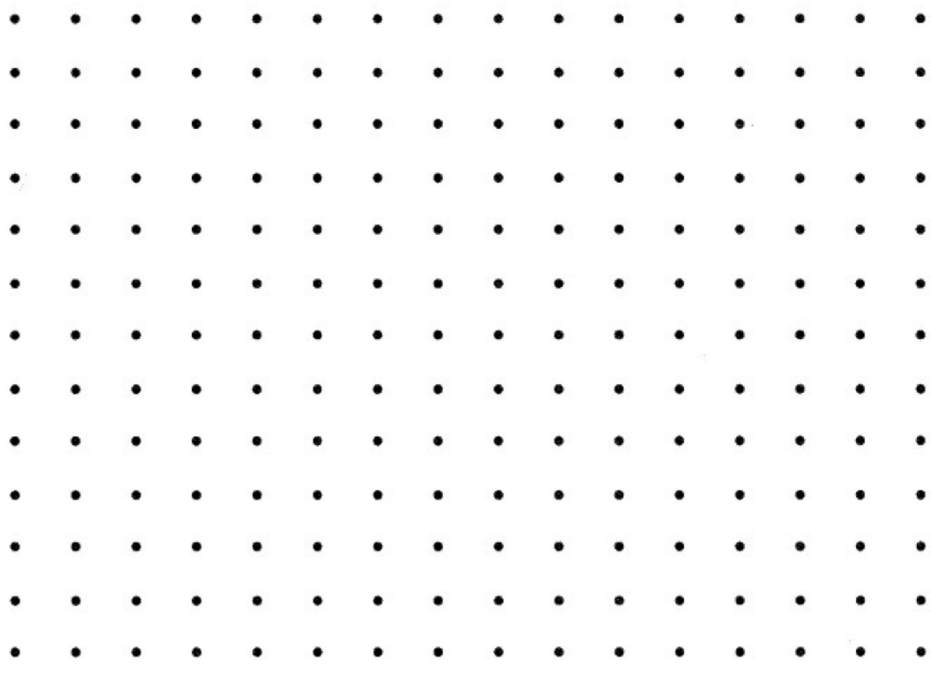

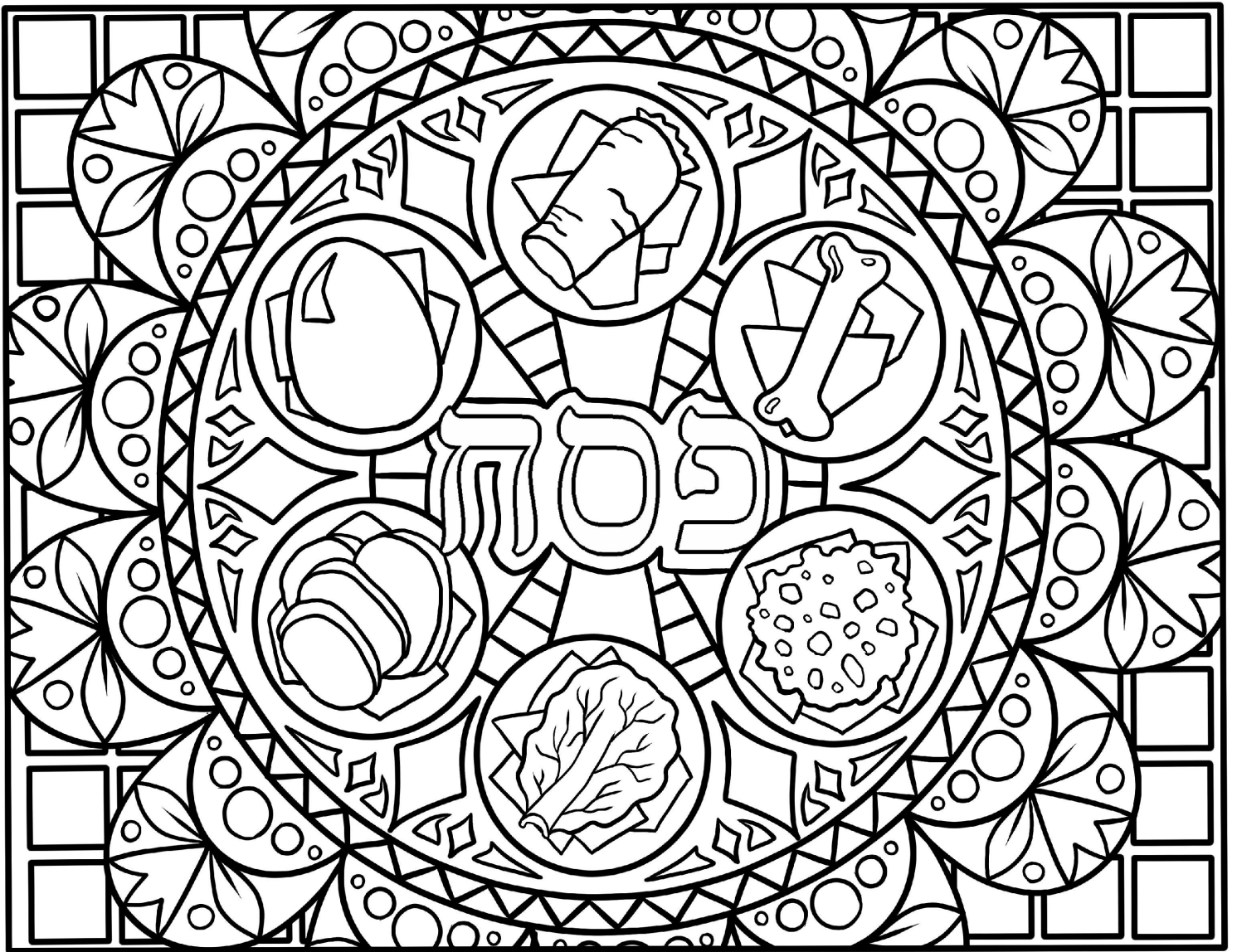
Passover Cootie Catcher

1. Print and cut round outside of cootie catcher
2. Fold in half and in half again
3. Open out, turn over so top is blank and fold each corner into the middle
4. Turn over and repeat
5. Turn over so you can see the pictures
6. Slide your thumb and your finger behind 2 of the pictures and press together so they bend round and touch
7. Turn over and repeat with the thumb and finger of the other hand for the other two pictures
8. All the pictures should now be at the front with centres touching and you are ready to use your cootie catcher!

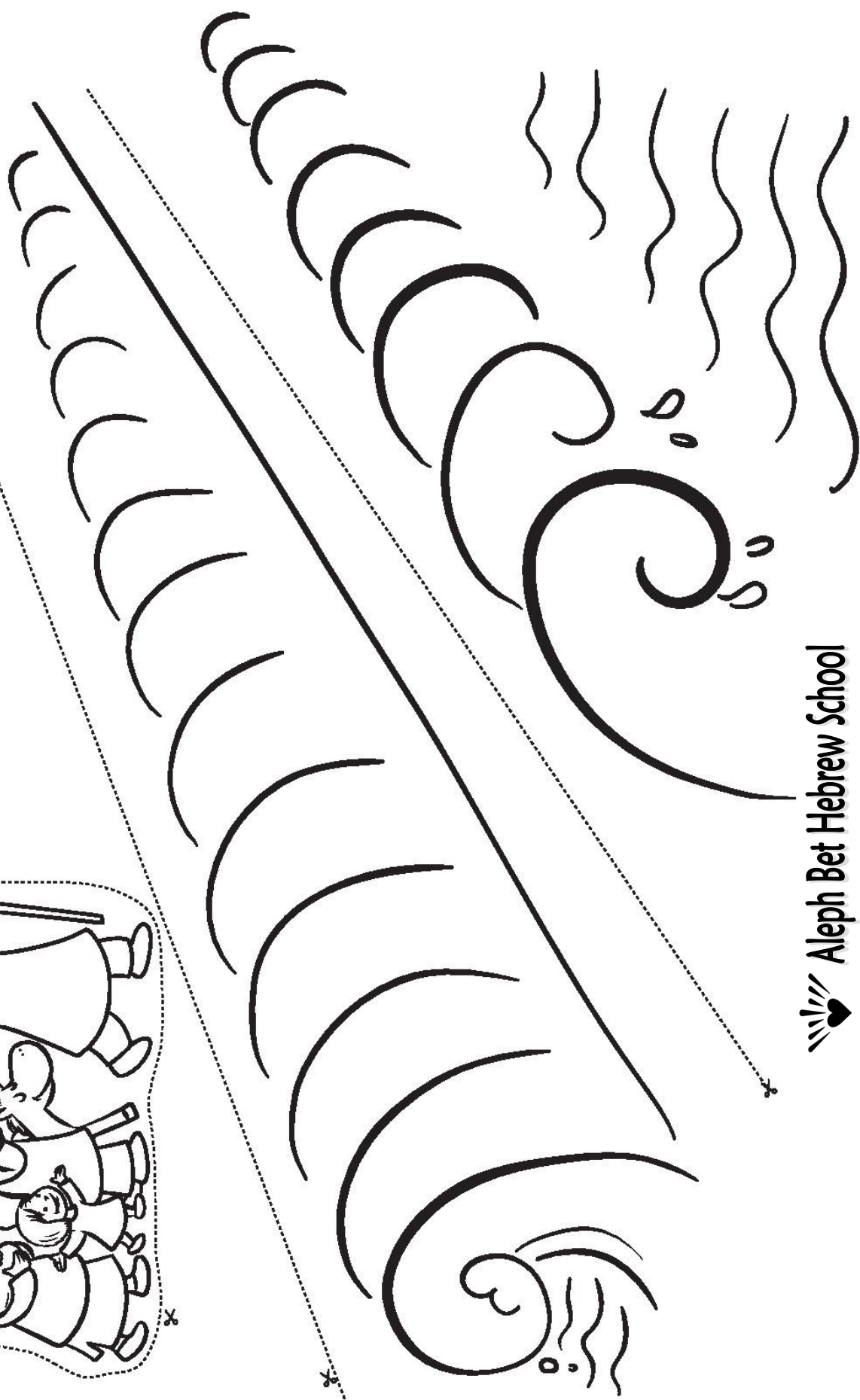
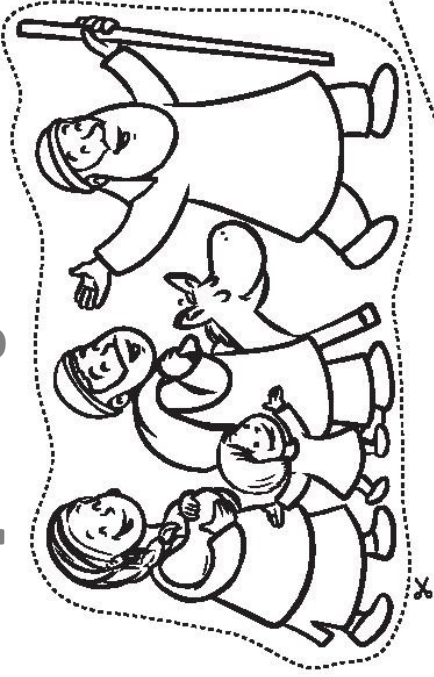

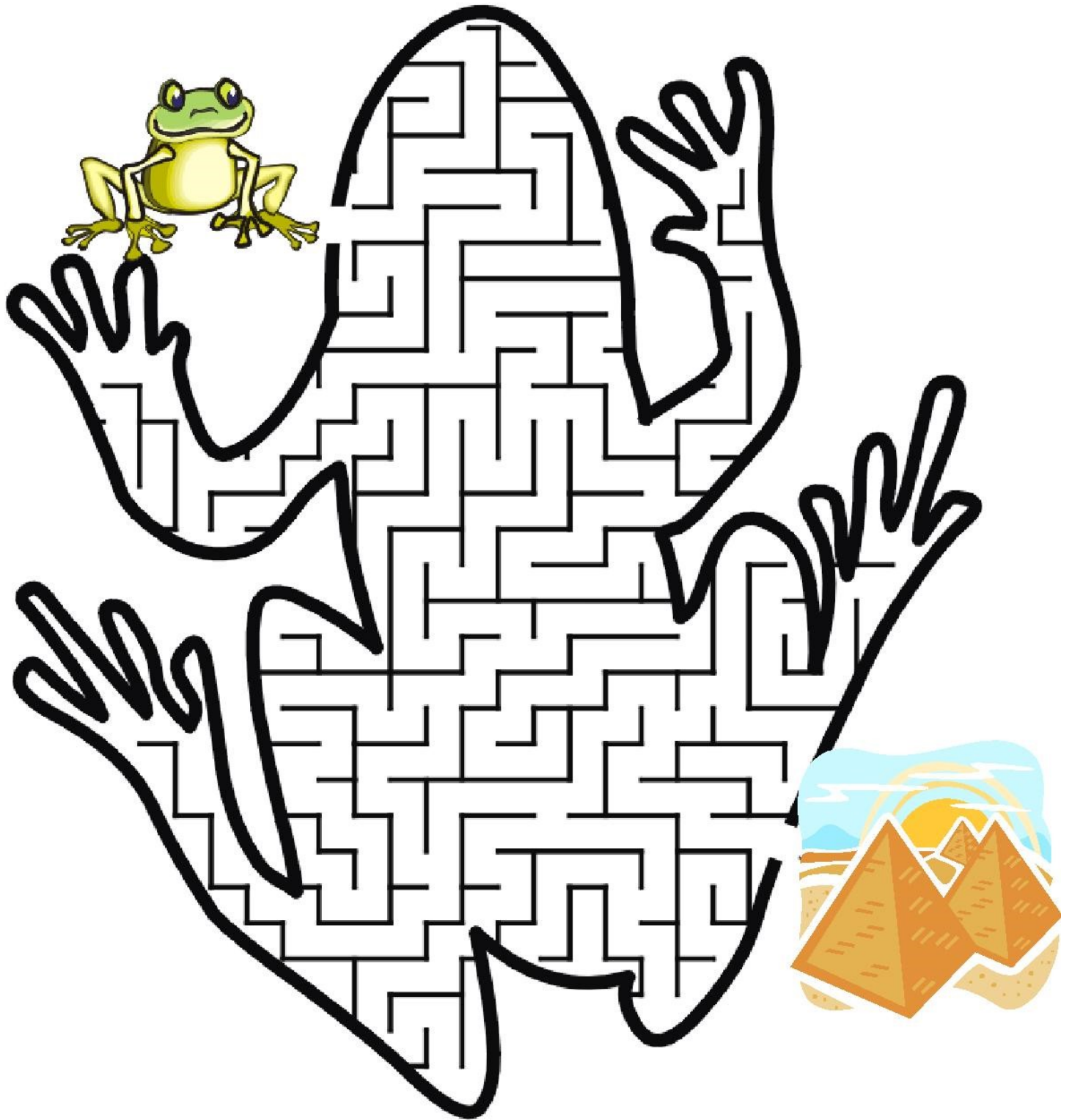


The splitting of the Sea

Cut along the dotted lines. Put the picture of the Jews on a popsicle stick or plastic spoon. Act out the Jews going through the split sea.



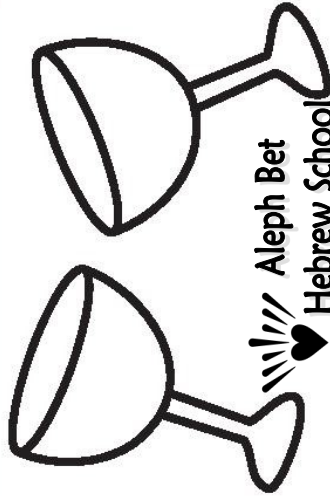
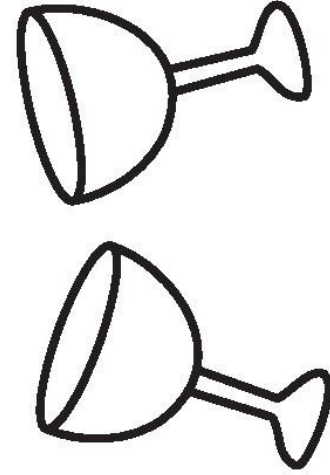
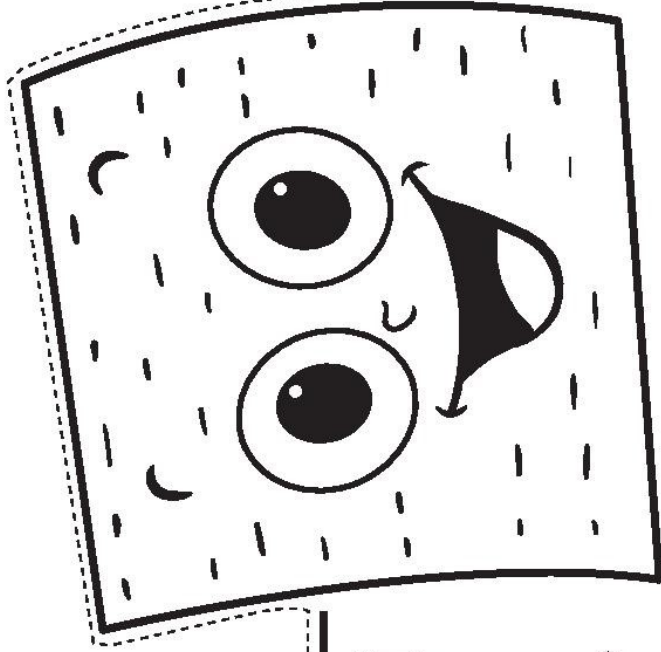
